Visit the Front Desk at Goergen Athletic Center from April until October to rent a bicycle at no charge* with a valid Undergraduate Student ID!

Bicycles come complete with a helmet and lock.

**Please note: Bicycles may be rented free of charge; however, renters may incur late fees and/or damage charges.*

Red Line Bus

Take the Red Line Bus from ITS (rear of Rush Rhees Library) on Library Rd. to the Eastman Campus. Busses operate continually on a daily basis. Faculty, staff, and students ride for free. Schedules are available outside Common Connection in Wilson Commons and online at sa.rochester.edu.

Taxis

Taxis are available for a nominal fee. Please see a representative from Common Connection in Wilson Commons for contact information of several reputable companies typically used by students.

Parking

River Campus – Visitors may purchase day passes from the Parking Booth on Wilson Blvd. adjacent to the Elmwood Ave. entrance. Parking lots are free after 7p.m. Monday through Friday and on weekends. Metered parking is also available on Wilson Blvd.

Eastman Campus – Parking is available in the East End Garage (accessible from East Main St. in either direction and, via East Ave., Scio and Swan Streets), at a number of nearby lots, and on the street. Parking in the East End Garage and on the street is free on weekends, and on weeknights after 6 p.m.

3. Turn left at Mt Hope Ave/NY-15
4. Continue on Byron St
5. Turn left at S Clinton Ave
6. Turn right at Court St
7. Take 1st left onto Chestnut St
8. Turn right at East Ave
9. Take 1st left onto Gibbs St

1. Head N on Gibbs St toward E Main St
2. Turn right at E Main St
3. Turn right at Scio St
4. Turn left at East Ave/NY-96
5. Turn right at Alexander St
6. Turn left at Mount Hope Ave/NY-15
7. Turn right at McLean St
8. Turn left at Wilson Blvd
