Bus trip to Washington, D.C.

Instructions, Rules, and Regulations

- This bus trip is for students who will be traveling to the overflow area of the Presidential Inauguration. No one on the bus will have tickets to the Presidential Inauguration.
- Students must behave appropriately.
- All University rules, as stated in the Student Code of Conduct apply.
- Alcohol, drugs, weapons, and other contraband will not be permitted.
- Students must listen to directions as they come from all Event Managers.
- Students must remain with the group at all times.
- Students must be courteous and respectful to everyone else on the bus.
- Students must bring at least \$25 in cash to spend on Metro, food, and other expenses.
- If students want to purchase souvenirs or have extra spending money, they should plan on bringing more than \$25.
- Students are responsible for any missed work or classes.
- Students are expected to arrive at ITS at **7:40pm** on Monday, January, 19, 2009.
- Students are expected to arrive at the buses with the group immediately after the Inauguration.
- If students are not with the group for any scheduled bus departure, the group reserves the right to leave without them.
- Students should dress appropriately. Expect to do a lot of walking in January.
- Plan for all weather. We will be standing outside for several hours.
- Students should not bring a lot of stuff with them. Everything that is brought should be able to fit in the overhead storage or under their seat on the bus.
- Event Managers reserve the right to place excessive luggage in the storage unit under the bus.
- Students are expected to maintain appropriate hygiene for the duration of the bus trip.
- Students are expected to report back to their assigned bus for the duration of the trip. Once buses are assigned, there will be no switching.
- Students must bring both their UR student id and another form of picture id.
- After purchasing a ticket, students must inform the Common Connection if they are unable to go and someone else is going to take their seat on the bus.
- Do not plan on carrying a backpack or credit cards into the overflow area for the Inauguration.
- Be advised that food and drink are not allowed on the DC Metro.
