Executive

The SA Annual Survey was released and open throughout the back end of the month. The over 350+ responses will guide our mission and priorities for the rest of our term as well as provide useful information and data for ongoing projects and initiatives!

The President and Vice President are meeting with public safety bi-weekly to work on the relationship between public safety and the student body. We have begun working with Student Life Leadership and Public Safety Leadership to set up roundtables with student leaders to address concerns with the protest policy and public safety.
